Nike is in shame today as startling new revelations about how the Nike franchisees are made came out. It is revealed that many teenagers are enslaved in sweatshops.

We talked to a few people in a Nike sweatshop in the Philippines and that is when we found out how bad Nike treats their workers. Then we met a girl called Rosa. She is only 16 years old and she has to 12 hours a day, 6 days a week, which is 72 hours every week. Nike says that their employees only work 60 hours maximum a week. What we would like to know is why Rosa works 12 hours more than the maximum limit.

Rosa gets paid £4's for a 12 hour shift but the money isn't much help since it has to be spent on food and rent.

When we interviewed Rosa she said "I went to work for Nike because I thought I could send money that I earn back to my family who are very poor. But I have to spend all my money on food and drink."

Then we interviewed Nike for their point of view and they said "We apologise to Rosa and we would like to say that is very rare that someone has to work in poor conditions like Rosa. We would also like to say that we stand by our rules, terms and conditions apply, see in store for details!"
