Reporter: Are you disturbed by the fact that your stuff is made by underpaid workers in the third world?

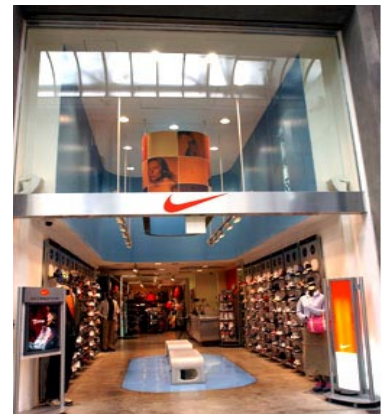
Paul: well yes and no because it is only clothes but they are treated unfairly.
